## **TAPS CROSS COUNTRY**

Our school cross country will take place on **Tuesday 4th August**. The first race will start at 12.45pm and the day should finish at approximately 2.30pm.

We hope the weather plays ball with us on the day. If we have to postpone the event, it will take place on Thursday 6th August in the morning.

Please note that:

- Apart from when they are racing, students should remain seated in their house groups.
- No student is to leave the venue
- Pupils are not allowed home early with their parents until after the cross country has finished.
- No child may go home with another family unless we have written permission from their parents.
- We encourage students to bring a named water bottle from home
- Students will only be released to go home after completion of the last race and when the grounds are tidy.
- This is a special request to parents not to gather at the finish line or where the children are sitting. There will be special seating for spectators opposite to where the children will be seated.



## **Classroom Round Ups**

#### Rm 1 Mrs Johnson

A big welcome to Korbin who joined our class today. This is a big week with cross country on Tuesday, a visit to KIndergarten on Wednesday and our Pyjama Day on Friday. Our Letterland work will be **t**, **n** and **g** and words that start with these letters. We are having a big phonological awareness drive in our class. Phonological awareness is a skill that allows children to recognize and work with the sounds of spoken language and it is the foundation for learning to read. I have included some information about this in your child's book bag today. In Maths we are working on number knowledge to 10 . We are focusing on reading and writing numbers correctly and counting and comparing sets. The children are looking forward to cross country, we hope you will be able to join us tomorrow to watch the event.

#### Rm 2 Miss Green

Everyone has settled in well. Room 2 has enjoyed getting to know our new classmates. We have cross country Tuesday afternoon and although the kids haven't had much time to practice, they are ready to give it their best!! We will continue to practice running everyday- weather permitting, to increase fitness. This week in writing we are focusing on recording all the dominant sounds we can hear in words and using word cards correctly. Some reading groups will be moving up a level and will have longer texts to read and different reading words to practice. In maths some children will be practising addition and subtraction using a number line and others addition within 10 and recording sums correctly. If you have any recycling at home (cardboard boxes, plastic containers, egg cartons, newspaper, bottle tops, etc) please send along to school as we will find use for it during play based learning.

#### **Rm 3 Mrs Bankier**

This week we are looking forward to cross country on Tuesday and Pyjama Day - 50 days of school since lockdown celebration. We have been learning the days of the week in Maori and NZ Sign language, please ask your child to share these with you. We will be learning how to ask the question 'What day it?' is this week. We are continuing to work on fractions, you can help at home by letting your

child experiment with measuring cups and spoons and talking about sharing equally.
